IMPORTANT NOTES FOR STUDENTS:

1. Students are to follow the FNU enrolment timetable and enroll at the earliest. The earlier you enroll, the earlier you will get the allowances.
2. All Bus Fare Allowances will be disbursed through the Vodafone M-Paisa Account in light of the E-Ticketing becoming mandatory from 1 October 2017. As such students must register for the M-Paisa services before the allowances are disbursed and provide their registered mobile number to TSLB. Other allowances may also be disbursed through M-Paisa.
3. Allowances for Trimester 3 will be paid in two or more batches to the students.
4. Any delay in the submission of results and enrolment reports will delay the allowance payment by TSLB.
5. Any TSLB sponsored student who wishes to add/drop courses after any part of the allowances has been paid will need to seek prior written approval from TSLB. Students must download and fill form TSLB 04 from TSLB website www.tslb.com.fj and submit to the TSLB staff at the nearest TSLB Office.
6. Allowances will be paid on pro-rata based on your academic load. You must be enrolled for full academic load for the term to be eligible for 100% of the allowances. If you are enrolled for 3 out of 4 units, you will get 75% of the allowances and so on.
7. All eligible Book, Incidental, Hostel and Meals allowances (NTS) and Food, Bus Fare and Rent Allowances (TELS) students will be deposited into the nominated bank account by the students.
8. ***IF YOU ARE STAYING IN THE HOSTEL YOU ARE REQUIRED TO PAY FOR ACCOMODATION AND MEAL ALLOWANCES FROM THE CASH RECEIVED BY YOU AND TSLB WILL PAY FOR ANY ELIGIBLE SHORTFALL AFTER RECEIVING THE INVOICE FROM THE FNU.*** Example:
 - For NTS Students, accommodation and meal allowance of \$2000 (on max.load) should be used to pay the hostel fees.
 - For TELS students, your weekly rent allowance plus your weekly food allowance plus your weekly bus fare allowance multiplied by 16 should be used to pay the hostel fees if staying in the hostel.
